

### DAY 1: WEDNESDAY

#### Arrive Zagreb

Welcome to Croatia. Your day is at leisure before meeting your Tour Director.

Dinner at the local restaurant.

Overnight at the hotel in Zagreb.

### **DAY 2: THURSDAY**

#### Zagreb - Ljubljana

Morning walking tour of Zagreb, home to a mix of 18th and 19th century buildings with many charming parks, squares and city markets.

Discover Ban Jelačić Square and medieval settlements of Gradec and Kaptol. See the Cathedral, Dolac Market, Tkalčićeva Street, Stone Gate and St Mark's Church on a guided walking tour.

Free time for a light lunch before heading to the Slovenian capital city of Ljubljana. Ljubljana lies in a basin between the Karst and Alpine region. This city with a soul features the Baroque Old Town nestled at the foot of Castle Hill, the Art Nouveau mansions and masterpieces of the renowned architect Jože Plečnik. Explore the city on a guided walking tour including the funicular train to Ljubljana Castle for amazing views across the city and surrounding region. In the evening enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.

Overnight at hotel in Ljubljana.

# DAY 3: FRIDAY

### Ljubljana - Lake Bled - Ljubljana

Lake Bled, together with its surroundings ranks among the most beautiful alpine resorts.

Enjoy a Pletna boat ride along the lake to Bled Island. See St Mary's Church and later continue to the old medieval castle up on the cliff. The enchanting views and fairy-tale beauty are sensational.

After sightseeing, enjoy a memorable lunch in Bled.

Continue to visit a local producer of honey, to learn about the beekeeping tradition in Slovenia and to sample their products. Return to Ljubljana for dinner at leisure.

Overnight at hotel in Ljubljana.

### **DAY 4: SATURDAY**

#### Ljubljana - Postojna - Predjama - Poreč

Morning departure from Ljubljana to Poreč, Croatia.

On route visit the stunning Postojna Caves, one of the world's largest karst monuments. For 140 years train journeys have been taking visitors through the caves to see the spectacular subterranean world.

Photo stop in Predjama Castle before stopping at an award-winning winery for a winery tour and tasting of famous local wines with snacks.

This evening, dinner at the hotel or local restaurant in Poreč.

### **DAY 5: SUNDAY**

#### Poreč - Motovun - Poreč

Morning guided tour of Poreč, home to the UNESCO World Heritage Site Euphrasius Basilica from the 6th century AD. Proceed to the gorgeous hilltop town of Motovun, possibly the most picturesque medieval hilltop town of inner Istria. After a tour of Motovun enjoy lunch locally, where you will experience a tasting of Istria's most famous delicacy, their truffles. Upon arrival back to Poreč, evening is at leisure.

We could possibly include a traditional pasta making class into the itinerary with lunch.

# DAY 6: MONDAY

#### Poreč - Rovinj - Pula - Poreč

Explore the Istrian peninsula. Visit Rovinj, one of the most romantic towns on the Mediterranean. Enjoy a tour and some free time to explore the town and its must see local markets, before meeting for lunch at a local restaurant.

Continue to Pula with its impressive Roman Amphitheatre, the Temple of Augustus and the Arch of Sergii. Visit one of Istria's renowned Oli

Dinner at lesiure and overnight in Poreč.

### **DAY 7: TUESDAY**

#### Poreč - Opatija - Plitvice Lakes

Morning departure for the Plitvice Lakes.

Enroute stop in Opatija for free time ar offee break. Opatija is one of the most popular seaside resorts on the Adriatic. It is often referred to as Croatia's Monte Carlo and was once the playground of the Austro-Hungarian nobility.

Continue to the Plitvice Lakes and enjoy an afternoon guided walking tour of the Plitvice Lakes National Park - sixteen lakes, inter-connected by a series of waterfalls, set in deep woodland populated by deer, bears, wolves, boars and rare bird species.

Dinner in Plitvice Lakes hotel and overnight.

### **DAY 8: WEDNESDAY**

#### Plitvice Lakes - Zadar - Šibenik

Morning departure from Plitvice Lakes to the Dalmatian Coast.

Vis Zadar, steeped in history, visit the Roman Forum and St Donatus Church, the manesque St Grisigono's Church, St Mary's Bell Tower and St Anastasia Cathedral. Take a stroll along its beautiful promenade with Sea Organ & Greetings to the Sur a sound and light spectacle and award-winning architectural space.

Enjoy free time for lunch before departing Zadar. Travel along the Dalmatian coastline where your next stop is Šibenik.

Dinner in hotel & overnight in Šibenik.

### **DAY 9: THURSDAY**

#### Šibenik - Skradin - Krka Waterfalls - Šibenik

Morning walking tour of Šibenik, the oldest Croatian city on the Adriatic. See Croatia's most beautiful monuted t, St James Cathedral.

Afterwards v uaint town of Skradin before continuing to the Krka Waterfalls National Park. Experience the natural beauty of the largest of the seven waterfalls, Skradinski Buk on Krka River. Visit the authentically restored ensemble of small stone houses, work bo, exhibits and watermills, and enjoy a beautiful walk through forest pathways and wooden bridges. Continue to a nearby villag b for a traditional Dalmatian lunch at a local estate.

Late afternoon arrival back to Šibenik, the rest of your day is at leisure.

### **DAY 10: FRIDAY**

Šibenik - Klis - Split

Morning departure toward Split.

On route stop at Klis, a medieval fortress built by the Illyrians over 2,000 years ago, offering breathtaking views of Split and the Adriatic Sea.

Continue to a family owned estate for a cooking class & lunch. Continue on to Split where the rest of the afternoon is at leisure.

Dinner at leisure in Split.

### **DAY 11: SATURDAY**

#### Split (Cruise Starts)

Morning at lesiure before transfer from the hotel to Split harbour for check in from 1400HRS onwards.

After settling in, enjoy the guided tour of Split, a historic town under UNESCO World Heritage protection with an abundance of Roman architecture. Of special interest is the magnificent Diocletian Palace, once the home to the Roman Emperor.

After the tour, return to the ship for a welcome meet & greet cocktail reception on board.

# **DAY 12 SUNDAY**

#### Split - Bol - Hvar

Morning departure to the island of Brač, where swimming is planned at the most famous beach in Dalmatia, Zlatni Rat near Bol. Its shingle promontory shifts from side to side as the wind and waves constantly cause the beach shape to change. Bol is a typical fishermen's village converted into a popular tourist destination, yet retaining its charm.

Continue towards the 'jet-set' island of Hvar with lunch on board at the Pakleni Islands. Hvar is the longest and sunniest island in the Adriatic, known for lush lavender fields and breath-taking beauty.

Arrive in the afternoon for a guided tour of the town's historical landmarks, the Renaissance cathedral with its original tower, and the oldest community theatre in Europe founded in 1612. Hike up the zigzag path to the town fort overlooking the harbour for lovely scenic views of the vessel and the Pakleni Islands. In the evening Hvar offers a great choice of entertainment, numerous restaurants, bars, and clubs with many open long into the night.

Overnight in the port.



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# DAY 13: MONDAY

#### Hvar - Biševo - Vis

Early morning cruise towards the small island Biševo to visit the Blue Cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon (entrance to be paid on the spot). As sometimes weather conditions can be very unpredictable, the possibility of a cave visit will depend on those conditions however, you will be notified in time.

Continue to the island of Vis, once a strategic naval Yugoslav base and closed to the public for years. Due to this isolation, Vis retains a special charm, 'the Mediterranean as it once was', making it interesting to visit. Situated on the northern side of the island, Vis has developed near the remains of ancient Issa, the first urban centre in Croatia. Sample local wines. If interested, visit the remains of the Roman Thermal Place, the City Museum or simply take a walk enjoying the views of the beautiful Villae Rusticae situated along the waterfront.

Overnight in the port of Vis.

# DAY 14: TUESDAY

#### Vis - Korčula

Early morning departure towards the island of Korčula, best known as the birthplace of Marco Polo. Stop for lunch in one of the secluded bays en route.

Afternoon arrival in Korčula followed by a guided walking tour of this enchanting town surrounded by walls and one of the best-preserved medieval cities in the Mediterranean. The fishbone street pattern was used in Korčula Old Town's design to provide a natural cooling effect providing citizens with sheltered and comfortable accommodation.

Optional excursion to a small village near Korčula for a typical Dalmatian dinner and to find out more about the history and traditional way of living.

Overnight in Korčula.



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### DAY 15: WEDNESDAY

#### Korčula - Mljet

The next morning, head further south to the Island of Mljet. The legend says Greek hero Odysseus spent years on this island when he was captured by the nymph Calypso.

Join the cruise manager for a stroll to the famous salt lakes in the Mljet National Park and enjoy the boat ride to St Mary Isle to visit an ancient Benedictine monastery, an old abbey and a Church dating back to the 12th Century. Alternatively, rent kayaks, bicycles, scooters, or convertible cars to roam around the National Park or island on your own, but beware of the nymphs! Enjoy the peace and tranquillity of the island.

Overnight in port Polača or Pomena.

# **DAY 16: THURSDAY**

#### Mljet - Slano - Ston - Slano

Departure for the small village of Slano on the mainland, a peaceful fishermen's village, and the starting point for Ston, another once fortified small village famous for its oysters.

After exploring the town's vast medieval ramparts, heading for a small village nearly ali Ston to learn more about oysters and a special tasting of this delicacy.

Transfer back to the vessel for the Captain's dinner with live entertainment.

### DAY 17: FRIDAY

#### Slano - Dubrovnik

Early morning departure to Dubrovnik, one of the world's most beautifully preserved medieval cities.

Before tind up at the Gruž Harbour, enjoy a cruise alongsid de old Dubrovnik city walls while lunch is served on deck.

After docking, transfer to the Old Town for the guided walking tour of this magical town.

Take the cable car from the Old Town to Srđ mountain to enjoy scenic views of the Walls and the Elaphiti Islands. Meander through the normal we streets, exploring the Gothic, Renaissance and Baroque architecture or walk on top of the 1940m long city walls.

Overnight in Dubrovnik.

# **DAY 18: SATURDAY**

#### Dubrovnik

Gather for one final breakfast on the vessel, followed by goodbyes to your crew and new friends.

Transfer to Dubrovnik Airport for your outbound flight.
