TUESDAY 13TH MAY

Cairo

Welcome to Egypt. After being met by our local operator inside immigration at the airport and assisted with all arrival formalities, you will have your first experience of Egypt as you are transferred to your hotel. Spend the evening soaking up the atmosphere of this ancient kingdom.

This afternoon refocus and gather your thoughts. You will meet your guide for a walking tour of Old Cairo. Start at Bab El Futouh and stroll through Al Moez Street visiting and viewing the magnificent Islamic architectural heritage including mausoleums, mosques, Sabils, and medieval houses that date from the Fatimid and Mamluke Eras. Rest and reenergize with a refreshing drink at Fishawy Café (Optional) amidst Khan El Khalili bazaars. No visit to Cairo is complete without a stop at the Khan El-Khalili bazaar, where you will be transported back in time to an old Arab souk. After the tour return to you hotel.





WEDNESDAY 14TH MAY


Cairo - Aswan (BLD)

Aswan, Egypt's sunniest southern city and ancient frontier town located about 100km south of Luxor, has a distinctively African atmosphere with the local Nubian population. Small enough to walk around and graced with the most beautiful setting on the Nile, the pace of life is slow and relaxing. In Aswan, the Nile is at its most beautiful, flowing through amber desert and granite rocks, round emerald islands covered in palm groves and tropical plants. Explore the souk, full of the scent and colour of spices, perfumes, scarves and baskets.

Upon arrival in Aswan take a felucca (traditional sailing boat) ride around the islands of Aswan before boarding your Nile Cruise Ship.

Starting operations in November 2015, the Blue Shadow has 54 deluxe cabins and 3 suites all of modern design along the line of hotels rooms. All guest cabins are on the Main or Middle Deck. Cabins feature A/C, minibar, satellite flat screen TV, panoramic windows & safe box. Facilities include on board entertainment, restaurant, lounge and pool bars, relaxing sauna and massage area and library.

Board your Nile cruise boat for the start of your journey along the life-giving waters that have transported Pharaohs, Royalty, and celebrities for eons. This afternoon visit the High Dam and the serene Temple of Philae. Dedicated to Isis, the island of Philae is said to be the resting place of her husband Osiris.





THURSDAY 15TH MAY

Aswan - Kom Ombo - Edfu (BLD)


Savour breakfast on board your boat as you cruise to the Temple of Kom Ombo. This temple, though not as well-known as others in Egypt, is a favourite amongst those who visit. Bas reliefs and carvings show such technological advances as surgical instruments and a pre-Georgian calendar, helping to remind us of just how advanced the Ancient Egyptians were. It also features a fascinating collection of mummified crocodiles. Later that evening cruise to Edfu.

FRIDAY 16TH MAY

Edfu - Esna - Luxor (BLD)

Today you will visit the Temple of Horus in Edfu and discover the remains of the Old Kingdom and the temple dedicated to the falcon God Horus, constructed during the Ptolemaic period between 237 and 57 BC. The walled descriptions describe its construction and also display important drawings, capturing the Greco-Roman era in ancient Egypt. Later sail across Esna Lock where floating peddlers will offer you their wares with some ingenious bartering from the waters of the Nile, before arriving in Luxor to visit the Temples of Karnak and Luxor. The Karnak Temple is remarked for the way it was continuously added to by a succession of Pharaohs over a period lasting more than a 1000 years – surely one of the longest running building projects in history.





SATURDAY 17TH MAY

Luxor – Cairo (B)

Disembark your cruise this morning and cross the Nile to explore the West Bank. Today is full of highlights including the Necropolis of Thebes and the Valley of the Kings, where you'll find the tombs of the Theban rulers including Tutankhamun. The grandeur of Queens Hatshepsut's Temple and the haunting Colossi of Memnon, named for the Ethiopian king who marched to the aid of Troy, round out the exploration before transferring to the airport evening flight to Cairo. Transfer from the airport to your Pyramids hotel – catching your first glimpse of this Seven Wonders.

SUNDAY 18TH MAY

Cairo (B)

A day to remember!. Explore the sand strewn temples and tombs before of incomparable Pyramids of Giza and Sphinx. The largest and oldest pyramid was built by Pharaoh Khufu over 3,800 years ago. From the oldest buildings in Egypt to the newest. Today trip with your Egyptologist takes you to the massive and inspirational GEM Museum the largest archaeological museum in the world. This stunning new museum showcases the ancient discoveries of Pharaonic Egypt. Using the latest architecture and technology this museum brings to life and display the pharaonic civilisation like it has never been seen before.

GEM is scheduled to open in April 2023 – If it has not opened then this will be replaced by the Cairo Museum.

MONDAY 19TH MAY

Cairo (B)

Take one last moment to reflect on your discoveries as you transfer to the airport.



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
